QS WORLD UNIVERSITY RANKINGS REGIONAL



Universiti Malaysia Pahang is ranked 132 in Asia and 25 in Southeast Asia based on the QS World University Rankings 2023 edition, Universiti Malaysia Pahang ranks among the top 18% in Asia, as released by Quacquarelli Symonds. This year, 100 universities in Asia were ranked for this year's edition, with 34 new entries from various universities around the world. Universiti Malaysia Pahang is at the top of the Malaysian Technical University Network (MTUN). Among the measures of excellence, Universiti Malaysia Pahang is ranked 61 in Asia.

Previously, Universiti Malaysia Pahang also managed to maintain the position at 801-1000 in the QS World University Rankings 2022. In the same position, the Universiti Malaysia Pahang score increased compared to the previous year. In the 2022 edition, 100 universities in Asia were ranked for this year's edition, with 34 new entries from various universities around the world.
